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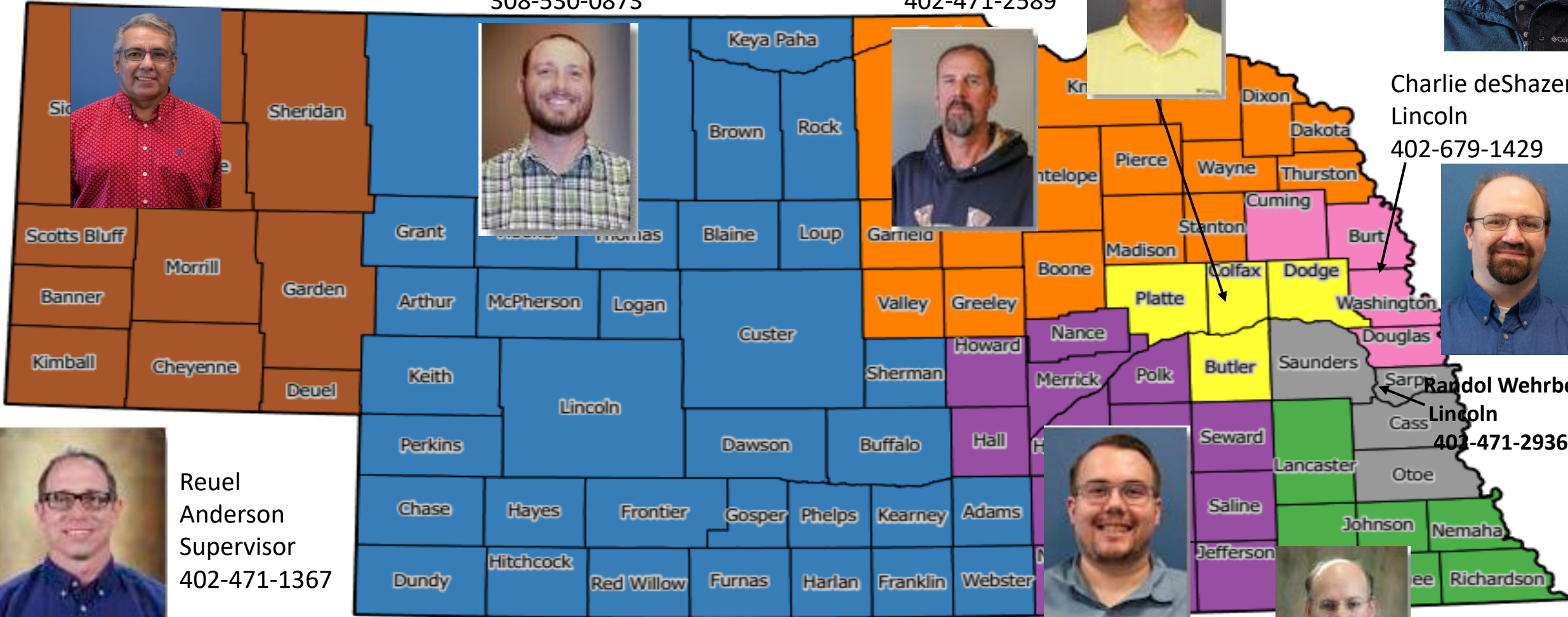

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Focus of Title 119 Revisions

- Reduce duplicative content already existing in the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) and State Statute
 - Incorporate updated NPDES regulations
 - General housekeeping
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Adopt by Reference

Incorporating by reference the applicable provisions of the regulations issued under 40 CFR, Title 40 as applicable to the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES)

- Most NPDES regulations fall under Subchapter D and Subchapter N
- Federal regulations for NPDES can be found online at:

Adopt by Reference - Example

Existing Title 119:

002.0210 A small MS4 is subject to storm water regulation as follows:

002.10A A small MS4 is subject to the NPDES storm water discharge permit requirement if it is located in an urbanized area as determined by the latest Decennial Census ...

The existing Title continues with paragraphs 002.10B through 002.10E4




Adopt by Reference - Example

Proposed:

002.02 A small MS4 is subject to storm water regulation as promulgated at 40 CFR §122.26(a)(9)(i) and §122.32

Outcome

- Reduction in the number of chapters in Title 119
 - Reduction in duplicative language
 - Correction of errata in existing Title
 - Incorporation of regulatory updates
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Outcome

Incorporation of regulatory updates includes:

- National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Electronic Reporting Rule
- NPDES Electronic Reporting Rule-Phase 2 Extension
- Clean Water Act Methods Update Rule (40 CFR 136)
- NPDES Updates Rule
- Updated Effluent Limitation Guidelines
 - Example - Effluent Limitations Guidelines and Standards for the Steam Electric Power Generating Point Source Category
