

Abstract of proposed changes to Title 126

Title 126 regulates the release of oil or hazardous substances into or upon land and the waters of the state. The Department is proposing to condense Title 126 and remove any duplicative or obsolete material. Any definitions in Chapter 1 that restate the statutory language of the Nebraska Environmental Protection Act, and any definitions that are no longer necessary due to the removal of obsolete chapters will also be deleted. Title 126 contains 14 chapters that are reserved. The 14 reserved chapters will be deleted. Chapter 2 prescribes the requirements for obtaining a permit under this title and the types of permits subject to the requirements. Chapter 2 is obsolete and will be deleted. The requirements of Chapter 10 and Appendix I, relating to the land application of paunch, are proposed to be moved to Title 132. Chapter 10 and Appendix I will be deleted. Chapter 12 merely references the requirements of Title 198 and is not substantive. Chapter 12 will be deleted. The contents of Chapter 18 will be retained with minor modifications to improve readability and condensed into Chapter 1.
