

2024 Nebraska Weatherization Assistance Program Application

Nebraska Department of Environment and Energy (NDEE)

RFP Questions as of 5/6/2024

Q: Is there flexibility for the time period between the notice of intent award (currently 6-1-2024) and start date (7-1-2024)? Meaning is there flexibility on start date for the provider to get things in place? Does start date mean intake and beginning work?

A: The start date will be effective the day both parties sign the subaward. NDEE is aware that the successful bidder will need time to gear up prior to beginning client intake and implementation of the work. NDEE expects production to be started within 6 months of the subaward start date to ensure the statewide average cost per unit (ACPU) is not impacted by delayed production in Douglas County.

Q: Is there a current waitlist of clients for the program? Or can provider utilize its own waitlist of clients that are within the targeted population of the program?

A: Yes, NDEE has a client waiting list provided by the previous subgrantee that has been continually updated as requests are received.

Q: Can providers use their own application for programming as long as it meets the requirements of the Weatherization Assistance Program?

A: Currently NDEE does not have a standardized application and subgrantees have created their own to work in conjunction with their other services. We do have certain demographic and authorization requirements, per our funding sources that must be included on the client application.
